Mission Day and NL-1331D

263 participants came to explore Darmstadt under the theme "City of Science." We welcomed visitors from France, Poland, Norway, Austria, Switzerland, the Netherlands, Belgium, and of course many from Germany — a successful event.

Beforehand, participants could prep via a Telegram quiz covering the 24 missions, the city, and the science behind it. Darmstadt's role as the European Space Center (essentially the European Houston) tied in perfectly with Ingress's ongoing Apollo quarterly theme.

Throughout the day, participants could pick up event swag like T-shirts, hoodies, and pins, plus a stamp for the Agent Passport. As a highlight, Biocards and free buttons with the theme logo were handed out during the photo session.

The NL-1331D was positioned right next to the photo spot — perfect for farming the counter toward the medal.

From there, many headed off to tackle the MD missions. We'd also shared recommendations for restaurants and cafés in Darmstadt for lunch or a coffee break, which were well received.

We wrapped up the day at "Oh Scoozi!" on the market square, which had kindly served as our operations hub all day. Many stopped by throughout the day for drinks, food, or to meet other agents.

Some arrived as early as Thursday to explore the area's sights and mosaics, and many stayed overnight, spending Saturday evening in Darmstadt. The weather cooperated beautifully — warm and dry — and we'd deliberately scheduled the date so Sunday could double as the 2nd Sunday, which many took advantage of, especially those traveling from farther away.

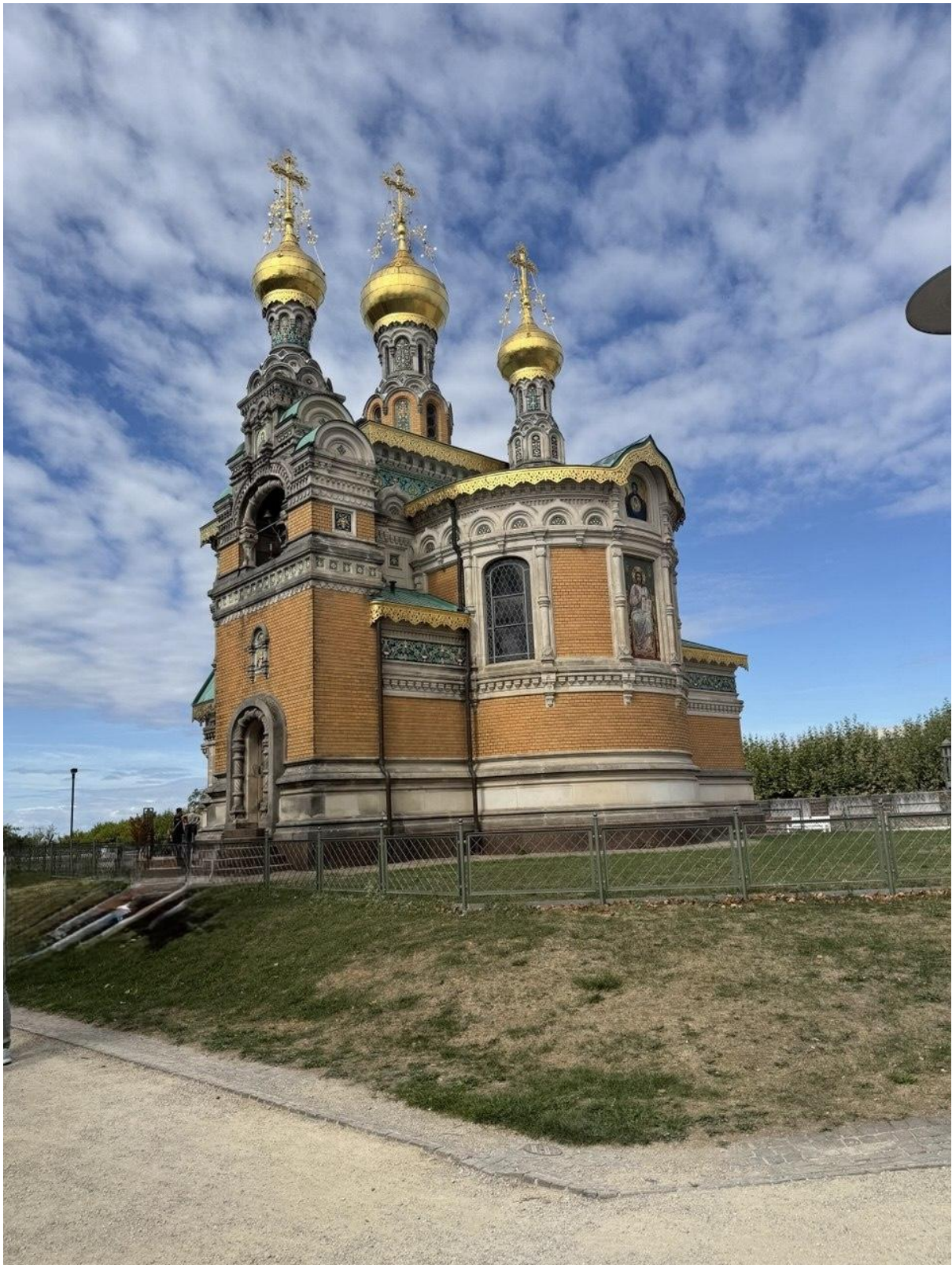

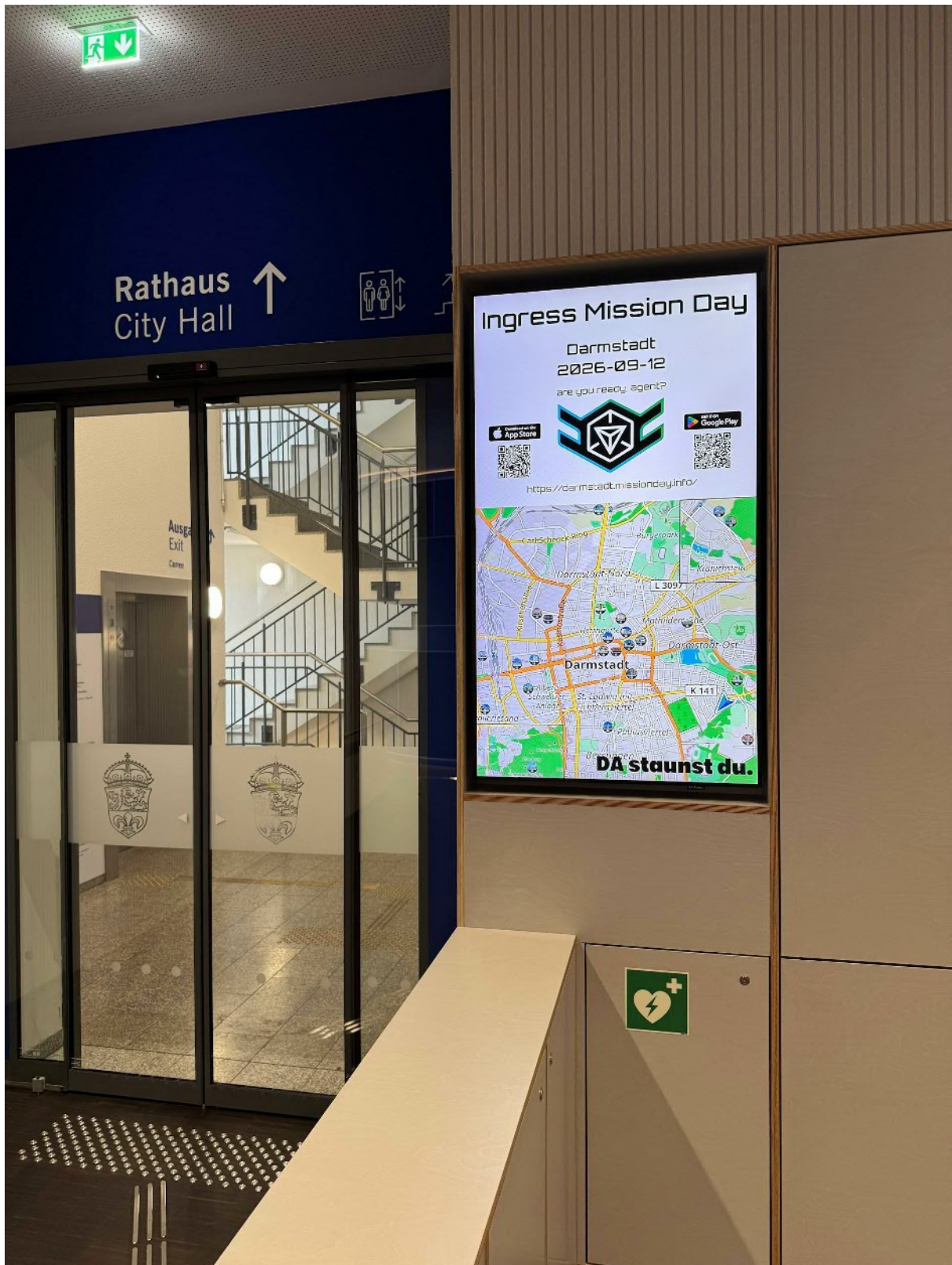
